How do I apply?

Take a look at all our opportunities under the 'Apprenticeship' section on careers.sunbeltrentals.co.uk. Click on the one that interests you and simply complete an application. Vacancies are also advertised on the National Apprenticeship Service website at www.gov.uk/apply-apprenticeship

What is the application process?

Once you have completed the online application you will receive a thank you email. The initial stage in the process is a telephone interview where we'll want to find out a bit more about you and why you want the apprenticeship. This is a good opportunity for you to find out a bit more about us and the role. If you're successful, you will then be invited to an interview with a manager at one of our centres.

Do I have to do any psychometric tests?

Depending on which apprenticeship you are applying for, you will need to complete one or two online psychometric tests. All the details will be sent to you by the training provider during the application process.

When will I find out if I have secured an apprenticeship?

We don't like to keep you waiting, so you will find out within three weeks of attending your interview whether you have been successful. Our apprentices start with us either in April or September.

What is the starting salary?

The starting salary ranges from £14,000 to £17,000 depending on age. There are some additional variations depending on apprenticeship type and level. As you progress each year, your salary will rise. A bonus is also paid at the end of each year completed, and on graduation.

Do I have to pay for my training?

All qualifications and training in relation to your apprenticeship are paid by us. If you attend a training course at one of our training centres across the country, travel and accommodation will be arranged for you.

Do I have to go to college?

Our engineering and technical apprentices attend college on a block release basis. If you're completing a customer service, business related, or driver apprenticeship you will not be required to regularly attend college since most of your training is carried out as work-based learning. You will be appointed a dedicated Assessor from one of our learning providers who will make regular visits to your workplace.

Do I have to pay for college transport, accommodation or meals?

If you are required to attend college, attendance can range from 12 – 16 weeks per academic year. You'll be required to stay at the college from Monday to Friday during block dates but can arrive on Sunday to help with travel arrangements. Naturally, we fund the college residency and transport expenses, including the cost of meals.

Will I get a college timetable?

You'll be given a timetable indicating when you are due at college for that academic year.

If your apprenticeship does not require college attendance, you'll be given a timetable of training events and workshops which you need to attend.

How long does my apprenticeship last?

Our apprenticeships vary in duration depending on the qualifications involved, but normally last between 1 and 4 years.

Will I have to pay for my uniform?

Your uniform and any tools or stationery you need will be supplied by us.

How many hours will I work?

You will be required to work 40 hours per week Monday to Friday. Your specific working hours will be agreed with your Manager when you start.

Will I have a job at the end of the apprenticeship?

Providing you have completed and passed the relevant training for your apprenticeship, we will ensure that you are offered a role which is relevant to your skillset.

If you wish to progress to a higher-level qualification to develop your skills further, we will explore what opportunities are available to you.



DIFFERENT ROLES FOR DIFFERENT SKILLS.

We offer a wide range of roles to suit your skills, interests and personality including

Customer Service Apprenticeship

Working in our Service Centres, you will be committed to maintaining our excellent customer service. This will involve handling internal and external customer enquiries, telephone orders and face to face customer interaction.

This apprenticeship is predominantly work-based learning with regular sessions delivered in-house, coupled with Assessor visits.

Construction Plant Maintenance Mechanic Apprenticeship

As a Construction Machinery Mechanic Apprentice, you will learn how to undertake planned preventative maintenance, fault diagnosis and repair of various mechanical and electrical specialist plant

This is a 2-year apprenticeship attending college on a block release basis whilst learning practical skills in the workplace.

Driving Apprenticeship

As a Driving Apprentice you'll be based at one of our Service Centres and be responsible for helping to ensure the smooth running of our logistics operation.

During an intensive Driver Training Programme, you'll have the opportunity to gain a range of qualifications and licences, including a Large Goods Vehicle and Forklift Truck Licences. You'll also attend quarterly training sessions to work towards gaining a full HGV Category Licence.

Electro Technical Apprenticeship

As an Electro Technical Apprentice, you will learn about the installation, testing, commissioning and maintenance of electrical and electronic devices and appliances. This is a 3-and-a-half-year apprenticeship and involves attending college on a block release basis.
